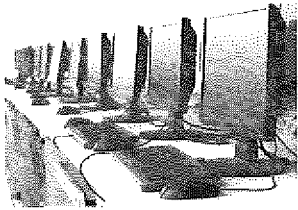

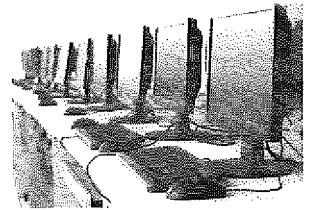

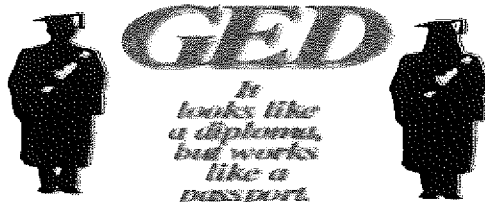
GED® TESTING

The GED® exam is delivered on computer through Pearson VUE testing centers. The test consists of four components: Reasoning through Language Arts, Social Studies, Science, and Math. Scores earned on previous versions of the GED examination (prior to January 1, 2014) may not be transferred to the new test. Individuals who wish to register to take the GED® exam must sign up online using the MyGED website, which can be found at www.GED.com.

Individuals who plan to register for the test must first create a profile on the MyGED website. An official practice test, called GED Ready, is also available on this website. Individuals may pay for and take the practice test online. The results will be provided, along with recommendations for additional study, if needed. Registration for the actual GED examination is also available through MyGED. Payment may be made online, a testing center may be selected, and one or more parts of the test may be scheduled.

The Adult Education office located at S. H. Clarke School, 2801 Turnpike Road, Portsmouth, is an authorized Pearson VUE testing center. Individuals who wish to take the test at that location may select that testing center when they register for the test at the GED.com website.

Important GED® Program Information

The GED® testing program has launched its new GED exam. Scores earned on previous versions of the test cannot be transferred to the new test. Individuals who did not pass all parts of the exam prior to January 1, 2014 must start over on the new 2014 GED exam.

Please note enrollment in Fast Track GED, GED Preparation, and Adult Basic Education Classes is continuous through May 25, 2017.

Fast Track GED® Class

This class is designed to dramatically reduce the time it takes to earn a GED® credential. Individuals who qualify in reading and mathematics are targeted for this class that will prepare these students to pass the GED® test within 90 days or less. This class is offered free of charge.
